Your Child Can Read! Product Use Guide

If your child can read at least 50 words:

Have your child begin by first watching Volume 1 once a day, 3 to 4 times per week for about one month. Progress through each volume and repeat a similar viewing schedule for the remaining volumes of the program. Go to www.lnfantLearning.com and use the tips to help your child read phrases and sentences and to help her read phonetically.

If your child is unable to read at least 50 words:

Please go to www.TheScienceOfEarlyLearning.com and read the Guidelines for Teaching Written Language for tips on helping your child learn his first 50 words. Please consider having your child use Your Baby Can Learn! prior to using this series if your child is age 5 or under.

Please use the five YBCL videos along with the Teaching Cards, Sliding Word and Picture Cards, Milestone Cards, Lift-the-Flap Books, Shape Bias Language Cards, and Lift-the-Flap Language Cards. Watch one or two Your Baby Can Learn videos a day and view Volume 5 a little more than the others. As soon as your child can consistently recognize at least 50 written words, please advance to the Your Child Can Read! program.

Your Child Can Read! Schedule

Watch Your Child Can Read! (YCCR) Volume 1 and also review the 5 YBCL videos until your child can read at least 100 words. Use all of the products in this kit, as well as the Sliding Phonics Cards or our other products available at www.YourBabyCanLearn.com. For children who can already read at least 100 words, watch YCCR Volume 1 for about one month or until your child can read most of the words in Volume 1 — whichever comes first.


Next, watch Volume 2 for about one month. Occasionally review Volume 1 of YCCR and the YBCL videos (especially Volumes 4 and 5 of YBCL). Go at a faster or slower pace based on whether or not your child is consistently reading the words.

Focus on Volume 3 for about one month. Continue to review the other YCCR DVDs at least twice a week and occasionally review the YBCL videos.



Do the same with Volumes 4 and 5 – focus on them for about one month while reviewing the other YCCR DVDs and reviewing the YBCL series.

- Periodically check your child's reading ability by showing him words from the videos. If your child is able to read the majority of the words, you should progress to the next DVD. It is important for your child to review the previously viewed videos to help reinforce the material until it is mastered.
- Please reduce the amount of entertainment-based television your child views at least until your child is reading independently. If you go to the library frequently and check out numerous books, this will be easier. Read the long-term studies on early reading so you understand the long-term benefits.

Your Child Can Read! Viewing Schedule



Regardless of your child's reading level, begin with Volume 1. It establishes the program's foundation for developing reading skills. Watch Volume 1 about twice a day for one month. Modify this based on the instructions at the top of the first page of this PDF about the number of words your child can read.





Volume 2 builds upon word families, while including fast-reading segments to help build your child's reading speed.

Review Volume 1 about once or twice a week until the material is mastered.





Volume 3 continues to teach phonics and introduces prefixes and suffixes in a way that is fun and exciting for your child.

Review Volume 1 about once a week and Volume 2 about twice a week.





Volume 4 has sections to help phonics, vocabulary, reading speed, comprehension, and learning prefixes and suffixes.

Review Volume 1 and Volume 2 about once a week and Volume 3 about twice a week.





Volume 5 introduces hundreds of new words. At this point your child will have seen all 200 of the most commonly used words in children's literature. Review each of the other volumes (Volume 1, Volume 2, Volume 3, and Volume 4) about once a week.
