Getting Started Is as **EASY** as **ABC**!

- A** **Allow** your baby to see and hear words frequently using our fun, multisensory, science-based approach. Point to the words in the books and on the word cards as you say them, then show or tell the meanings of the words. Go to TheScienceOfEarlyLearning.com to learn important information about the science behind Your Baby Can Learn!
- B** **Be** careful about showing entertainment-based videos to your child. Research on babies watching television clearly shows that the content matters. Please reduce or eliminate entertainment-based videos during your child's early years of life. Your Baby Can Learn! has more than 10,000 spoken words in the sentences of its five videos and is designed to teach language skills.
- C** **Children** progress at different rates based on numerous factors, so use the following schedule as a general guide. In most cases, do not go at a slower pace than the recommended schedule. If your child consistently recognizes most words, go at a faster pace.

Months	Suggestions	Products to Use
1 1 st half of the first month of using YBCL 1 2 nd half of the first month of using YBCL	<p>Begin with YBCL Volume 1 Classic regardless of your child's age. Allow your child to watch about twice a day for about a week. Then alternate with YBCL Volume 1 Newer, watching Volume 1 about twice a day for the next week.</p> <p>About two weeks after starting YBCL, introduce YBCL Volume 1 Sentences. Alternate Volume 1 Classic, Volume 1 Newer, and Volume 1 Sentences for the next two weeks. Watch YBCL about twice a day and look at the viewing schedule on the Volume 1 DVD.</p>	
2 2 nd month of using YBCL 3 3 rd month of using YBCL	<p>Focus on YBCL Volume 2 Classic. Allow your child to watch twice a day for one month. Some older children may be able to go at a faster pace. Review YBCL Volume 1 Classic, Newer, and Sentences once or twice a week for this month.</p> <p>After watching Volume 2 Classic for a month, introduce YBCL Volume 2 Newer. Alternate between Volume 2 Classic and Volume 2 Newer for one month, watching Volume 2 about twice a day. Review YBCL Volume 1 videos about twice a week.</p>	
4 4 th month of using YBCL 5 5 th month of using YBCL	<p>Focus on YBCL Volume 3 Classic. Allow your child to watch twice a day for one month. Review each of the five previously viewed videos (all versions of Volume 1 and Volume 2) about once a week during this month.</p> <p>After watching Volume 3 Classic for a month, introduce YBCL Volume 3 Newer. Alternate between Volume 3 Classic and Volume 3 Newer for one month, watching Volume 3 about twice a day. Continue to review the earlier videos.</p>	
6 1 st half of the 6 th month of using YBCL 6 2 nd half of the 6 th month of using YBCL	<p>Focus on YBCL Volume 4 Classic. Allow your child to watch about twice a day for about two weeks. Review the seven previously viewed videos (all versions of Volume 1, Volume 2, and Volume 3) once each during these two weeks.</p> <p>After watching Volume 4 Classic for 2 weeks, introduce YBCL Volume 4 Newer. Alternate between Volume 4 Classic and Volume 4 Newer for the next two weeks, watching Volume 4 about twice a day. Review previously viewed videos about twice a month.</p>	
7 1 st half of the 7 th month of using YBCL 7 2 nd half of the 7 th month of using YBCL	<p>Focus on YBCL Volume 5 Classic. Allow your child to watch about once or twice a day. Review the 9 previously viewed videos once or twice a month.</p> <p>After watching Volume 5 Classic for 2 weeks, introduce YBCL Volume 5 Newer. Alternate between Classic and Newer for the next two weeks, watching Volume 5 about once or twice a day. Review previously viewed videos once or twice during these two weeks. After this, flip this paper to see if your child is ready to start Your Child Can Read!</p>	

The months listed on the product schedule are the suggested lengths of time for watching each of the videos—not your child's age. At each step of the program, please also review the books and word cards from previous volumes. Please check to see if our Your Baby Can Learn! App is available. After 7 months of using YBCL, select the schedule that best fits your child's ability level:

- A. My child cannot consistently recognize at least 20 written words.
- B. My child can consistently recognize between 20 and 100 written words.
- C. My child can consistently recognize at least 100 written words.

A: Continue to allow your child to watch one or two Your Baby Can Learn! (YBCL) videos a day in a random order. Play with words using the Sliding Word and Picture Cards, Lift-the-Flap Books, Teaching Cards, Milestone Cards, Shape Bias Language Cards, and Lift-the-Flap Language Cards as well as whiteboards, chalkboards, paper, and other materials. Get more tips from our customer website at InfantLearning.com. Once your child can consistently recognize at least 20 written words, move to letter B below.

B: Begin watching Your Child Can Read! Volume 1 about three times a week, but mostly continue using the five volumes of YBCL. Use the Teaching Cards, Sliding Word and Picture Cards, Milestone Cards, and Lift-the-Flap Books as well as the 11 YBCL videos. Watch one or two videos a day and view Volume 1 Sentences and both versions of Volume 5 a little more than the others. As soon as your child can consistently recognize at least 100 written words, move to the Your Child Can Read! schedule below.

C: Advance to the Your Child Can Read! schedule below. Continue using the YBCL books and word cards.

Your Child Can Read! Viewing Schedule

1

If your child can read at least 20 words and you have the Your Baby Can Learn! (YBCL) series, please introduce the Your Child Can Read! series and review the YBCL series. Watch Your Child Can Read! **Volume 1** about 3 times a week and continue reviewing YBCL daily, especially Volume 1 Sentences and Volumes 4 and 5. Once your child can read at least 100 words and has watched YCCR **Volume 1** for at least a month, advance to **Volume 2**.

If your child can already read at least 100 words or is over age 5, start by watching Your Child Can Read! **Volume 1** once or twice a day for about one month or until your child can read most of the words in the video – whichever comes first. Then advance to **Volume 2**. During this time, continue reviewing YBCL, especially Volume 1 Sentences and Volumes 4 and 5, until your child masters those words.



2

Volume 2 includes additional word families and adds faster reading segments.

Watch **Volume 2** once or twice a day for about one month. During this month, also review **Volume 1** about once or twice a week until the material is mastered.



3

Volume 3 adds many new vocabulary words and it introduces prefixes and suffixes!

Allow your child to view **Volume 3** for about one month. Review **Volume 1** about once a week and **Volume 2** about twice a week.



4

Volume 4 has sections focused on phonics, vocabulary, reading speed, comprehension, and learning prefixes and suffixes.

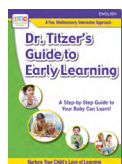
Allow your child to view **Volume 4** for about one month. Review **Volume 1** and **Volume 2** about once a week and **Volume 3** about twice a week.



5

Volume 5 introduces hundreds of new words. At this point your child will have seen all 200 of the most commonly used words in children's literature.

Allow your child to view **Volume 5** until your child has mastered the material. Review each of the other volumes (**Volume 1**, **Volume 2**, **Volume 3**, and **Volume 4**) about once a week.
